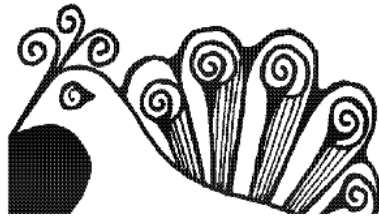

## **The Ascension of the Lord**

### **Reflecting on God's Word**

These days most corporations and churches have vision and mission statements. Often they begin with a model vision that the institution strives to live up to. They go on to state what the institution seeks to do ~ how it puts its vision into practice. A parish vision and mission statement might say: “We are the Body of Christ. On this feast we are given the ultimate vision and mission statement for the Church. It goes something like this: Christ is now working with and for us “at the right hand of God” (**Mark 16:19**). We seek to do so by “proclaiming the gospel to every creature” (**Mark 16:15**) and “building up the body of Christ, until we all attain to the unity of faith and knowledge of the Son of God” (**Ephesians 4:12–13**). ~ Virginia Stillwell

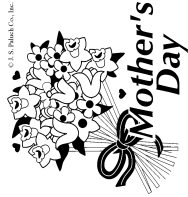










